

Plastic Pollution Bingo

This is an opportunity for your class to have a fun game of bingo whilst discussing the answers and reinforcing their new knowledge. You can use the questions as prompts to begin each discussion point.

Instructions

Mix up the order in which you give the questions. There will be three rounds (and three winners) for each game. To win the first round, you must get a sticker in each box of one row (horizontal only). To win the second round, you must get a sticker in each box of two rows (horizontal only). To win the final round, you must get a sticker in every single box.

Notes

After each round, keep the stickers in the boxes of the bingo card questions that have been answered - do not remove them. Any pupil can put a sticker in their box if the answer is correct, regardless of whether they answered the question or not.

Questions

1. We know that we can recycle but what are the other two R's?
 - Reduce and Reuse (2 answers)
2. What can you use instead of a plastic bag to carry your shopping in?
 - Canvas Bag (1 answer)
3. What plastic items are commonly found in the oceans?
 - Plastic bottle, Plastic Bag and Plastic Toys (3 answers)
4. How does plastic get into the oceans?
 - Off a boat, washed out to sea (2 answers)
5. Why is plastic dangerous to human beings?
 - Poisons people (1 answer)
6. How long does it take for plastic to degrade?
 - Over 1000 years (1 answer)
7. How many species are harmed each year by plastic around the world?
 - 663 species (1 answer)
8. In what way does plastic get onto our plates?
 - Food chain (1 answer)
9. What percent of plastic makes up the litter on UK beaches?
 - 60% (1 answer)

10. How much plastic was found on a UK beach in 2010?
 - 100,00 pieces (1 answer)
11. What do plastic bags sometimes look like to turtles?
 - Jellyfish (1 answer)
12. How many seabirds are killed by plastic waste each year?
 - Over 1 million seabirds (1 answer)
13. How much plastic waste was created in 2012?
 - 32 million tons (1 answer)
14. Name some marine animals that are affected by plastic in the oceans?
 - Penguin, Stingray, Shark, Turtle, Clownfish, Seahorse (6 answers)
15. How many plastic bags are used worldwide every year?
 - 500 billion (1 answer)
16. How does plastic pollution impact the oceans?
 - Destroys habitats, Poisons marine life, Entangles marine animals (3 answers)
17. What should you do instead of buying bottles water?
 - Drink tap water (1 answer)
18. Where is plastic pollution a problem?
 - Everywhere (1 answer)
