




Environmental Cost of BOTTLED WATER

The

consumed globally each year

Billion bottles of water are



more expensive

It takes three times the volume of water to manufacture the plastic for one bottle than it does to fill it



There are 150 water bottles consumed per second in the USA



consumed per year

17,000,000 Barrels of oil are used per year to manufacture bottled water

barrels of oil per year... of all plastic manufactured worldwide ends up in the ocean, never degrading

Pumping, processing, transportation and refrigeration of bottled water is estimated to use around 50 million


wherever they can, and the bottled water industry is an important component in their drive to commoditise what many feel is a basic human right - the access to safe and affordable water.
